Guidelines for filling Entrance Examination form 2009

(Please read the following instructions carefully, before filling the entrance examination form)

1. Eligibility

A. B.Ed./B.Ed. Spl-HI/ B.Ed. Spl-VI

Candidates with at least 45% marks in the Bachelor's Degree or 50% marks in Master's Degree with at least one school subject* as main subject** at the graduation level, are eligible for admission.

* **The School subjects are:** Hindi, Sanskrit, English, Science (Physics and/or Chemistry), Biology (Zoology and/or Botany), Mathematics, Economics, Commerce, History, Geography, Political Science (or Civics).

** The **main subjects** are those whose marks contribute to the aggregate in the final (degree) marksheet and the subjects have been studied at least for 2-years in the graduation/post graduation level.

B. M.Ed.

Candidates who have obtained at least 55% in aggregate in B.Ed. Degree are eligible for admission.

C. M.Ed. Special Education - VI/ M.Ed. Special Education - HI

- i. A candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed (Special Education) with at least 50% marks in aggregate in respective disability area from a recognised university or any other degree considered equivalent to B.Ed. (Special Education) from an affiliating university and/ or teaching department under any university recognised by U.G.C.
- ii. A candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed General course and has successfully completed a one year Diploma Course in special Education in respective disability area recognised by the Rehabilitation Council of India with minimum 50 per cent marks in each course.
- iii. B.Ed. with multi-category will not be admitted for specialization in a single disability at the M.Ed. level.

Date of entrance examination will be notified on receiving the recognition from RCI.

2. Admission will be made on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance examination conducted by the University, as per the policy of the University.
3. Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC, Women, aluminous etc. as per State Govt. /University norms.
4. Please make sure that the following documents are to be enclosed with the application form:
 - i. **Demand Draft of Rs. 500/- in favour of Finance officer, J.R.H. University payable at S.B.I. Chitrakoot (Branch Code 3869). Entrance Examination fee may also be deposited at the University counter.**
Last date: 25 April 2009 (10 May 2009 with late fee of Rs. 150).
 - ii. **All supportive documents should be self attested.**
 - iii. **Disability certificate issued by Chief Medical Officer (Minimum %age of Disability should be 40%)**
5. Disability certificate of the selected candidates will be examined by the Medical Board during counseling.
6. Appearing candidates in qualifying examination may also apply, but they are required to produce their mark sheet/certificate at the time of counseling.
7. **Candidates shall be provided OMR sheet for Entrance Examination.**
8. **Result of the entrance examination will be available on the website www.jrhu.com on 26 May 2009.**
9. **Counseling will be held as per following schedule at University campus:**
 - a) **B.Ed. - 9 July 2009 - from 10:00am to 3:00pm**
 - b) **B.Ed. Special VI/HI - 10 July 2009 - from 10:00am to 3:00pm**
 - c) **M.Ed/M.Ed Spl-VI - 11 July 2009 - from 10:00am to 3:00pm**

Note- - All successful candidates are required to report at university on the said date for counseling. No separate communication will be sent.

- In absence of any document required, students will not be allowed to get admission.
